### **Theodore Judgement is Being Appealed and You Can Help!**

I am pleased to inform Holy Trinity Catholic School community that both the Saskatchewan Catholic School Boards Association (SCSBA), which makes up all Catholic school divisions in the province, and the Government of Saskatchewan will appeal the Theodore Case ruling, which states that the government should no longer fund non-Catholic students attending Catholic schools.

The appeal will cost money and Saskatchewan Catholic Boards of Education are hoping to fund the legal costs without using funds from their operations. Boards wish to protect the operational funding which goes toward classrooms and learning. Therefore, the SCSBA has developed an Appeal fund so that Catholic education supporters throughout the province have an opportunity to donate to the appeal's costs.

This appeal is critical to protecting the choice parents presently have when seeking a Catholic faith-based education for their children. We ask you to consider helping fight for that choice by contributing to *A People of Faith* Campaign.
