Report Cards

Band and choral classes run both semesters. Students receive mid-term marks in January. Attendance, musicianship and leadership are constantly being assessed for these evaluations, though more formal evaluations take place in January and June.

Choir and Band Uniforms

The uniform for **boys** is a white dress shirt with collar, tie (preferably with some black or dark red hues; no novelty ties of any kind please), black dress pants, socks and dress shoes. All boys will need to purchase a vest. I believe you can find new black dress vests at Walmart.

The uniform for **girls** is black dress pants or skirt, black dress shoes (closed toe is preferable, with sensible heels as we sometimes stand for long periods of time). All girls will need a black choir shirt. An order form will be sent home in the coming weeks. **Everyone will need a complete uniform by December 1st.**
